9. 1 The transcripts of the eighth meeting of SWC was communicated first and passed by the members of the committee. Subsequently, actions taken on the suggestions of the eighth meeting were elaborated.

9.2 Salient Points of the ninth Meeting:

9.2.1 As the senior students are not in the campus, only 6 first year students attended the meeting representing the first year student community. They are reportedly happy to get to the college finally, after 4 months of online classes. They have no complaints regarding teaching or infrastructure facilities of the college.

However, one of the students, Joel K Joshy of S1 ECE raised the issue that the hostellers are directed to get back to hostel by 5 p.m. They considered it as too short a time period to relax. They were made to understand the reason behind such a decision. All the students of the hostel are there after doing the COVID screening test. If any of the students come into contact with too many outsiders by visiting eateries or shops, they are exposing the other hostellers as well to COVID risk. So the decision to close the hostel gates at 5 was taken to prevent such untoward instances. The students were convinced of the rationale behind the decision.

9.2.2 Next, Ms. Jayasree R Nair of DEE mentioned about the complaint from the Ladies hostel regarding the non availability of Wi-fi facility over there. We assured them to rectify the issue by communicating with the hostel warden and taking the necessary steps to sort out the issue.

As there were no other matters for discussion, the meeting got over by 12.45 p.m.
